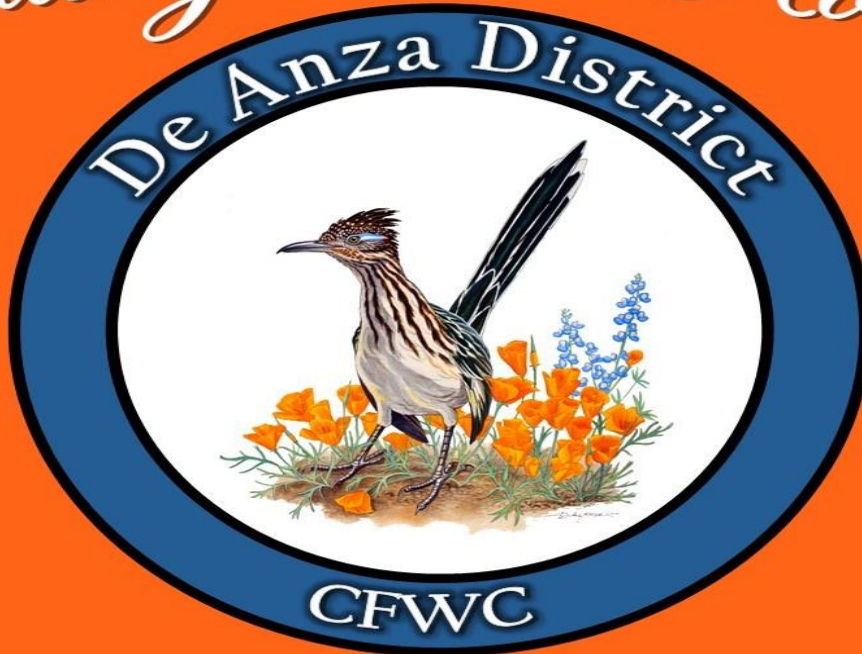

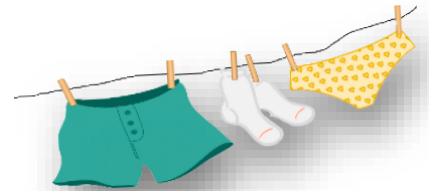

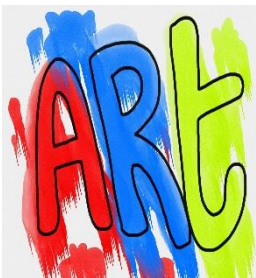
Health and Wellness Program
